
The project will run for a period of **12 months (1 year)**, commencing on the **1st January 2018** and will engage passionate, dynamic and enthusiastic **youth** who have the interests of their community and environment at heart. During the year, participants will be involved in 3 main components of the project:

-  Skills development (Accredited training)
-  Environmental service (Community service)
-  Exit opportunities (Employment/Self-employment/Further training)

The participants must be prepared to be involved in a variety of work place activities such as Administration, Clean up Campaigns, Recycling, Gardening, Tree Planting, Assistant Teaching etc
It is essential for all prospective participants to meet the following criteria:

-  Be a resident in the above-mentioned areas
-  Be between the ages of 18 to 35
-  Be unemployed
-  Must have Matric/Grade 12
-  Must have any environmentally related qualification (an added advantage)
-  Must have community work experience (preferable)
-  Must have a good understanding of speaking, reading and writing English
-  Must have a passion for environmental and social issues
-  Must have no criminal record

To apply: interested youths must visit the Delta Environmental Centre website to obtain application forms for the YES Project of 2018. The application forms must be completed and submitted with the following documents:

-  A letter of motivation (why you should be considered for the project)
-  2-page CV with three contactable references
-  Certified ID copy (not older than three months)
-  Certified copies of qualification certificates relevant to the criteria above
-  Certified proof of residence in the above area (in your own name or parents)
-  Medical proof of any disabilities (if any)
-  Letter from the Ward Councillor confirming your residential status
-  *Appointed participants will be required to submit Police clearance certificate*

Please note, failure to submit any of the above documents will lead to disqualification of your application.
